Synopsis:

On the 27th of August 2021, the batches of MBA - AB, 2020-22 & EE, 2020-23 attended a Guest Lecture by Dr. Prasad Modak, Executive President, Environmental Management Center LLP. The topic for the session was "Is Circular Economy more than just Waste Management?".

Dr. Modak initiated the session by providing the statement of challenges caused by Urbanization. He delivered an explanation of concepts like Resource Consumption and Resource Productivity, and how they gave rise to Resource Security. The discussion gradually shifted towards Linear and Circular Economic Growth and its relevance in the Circular Economy. Dr. Prasad then elaborated on the structure of Circular Economy, calling it a Paradigm Shift and in the field of Corporate Governance. An emphasis on Key Strategies like Inner Circle, Circling Longer, Cascading, and Pure Inputs was given by Dr. Prasad.

Dr. Modak then discussed the role of Governance in Circular Economy and the various guidelines to be followed to execute it. Finally, the Four Pillars of Circular Economy were highlighted and thoroughly explained by the speaker. The session ended with a very insightful and thought-provoking Q&A session
