# WORKSHOP REPORT

## **Synopsis:**

On 18th September 2021, the MBA-E&E 2020-22 batch attended a workshop conducted by Mr. Prabodha Acharya, Chief Sustainability Officer, JSW Group. The topic for the session was "Sustainability at JSW and the Steel Industry."

Mr. Acharya initiated the session by providing the attendees with a brief overview of the objectives of JSW Group as a business. He explained the overall perception of Sustainability by presenting intriguing analogies. Mr. Acharya discussed a shift in the business outlook from the traditional responsibilities to an approach targeted at Risk Management and Mitigation. He also highlighted the importance of Materiality and provided a thorough presentation about the Governance Strategy and frameworks applied at JSW. Various topics included Sustainability Frameworks and Priorities, where Mr. Acharya explained the importance of prioritizing 17 focus areas identified as material issues and developing a strategy around them. Climate Change Policy is another aspect of frameworks and Environmental Management and Biodiversity Conservation that JSW Group considers while developing their strategy. Mr. Acharya also shed some light on the importance of Circularity and Eco-Labeling. The difference between Green Hydrogen and Blue Hydrogen was explained briefly by Mr. Prabodha. The session was highly interactive and concluded with a series of engaging and enlightening questions and answers.
