ICE AGE, IMT Nagpur

Nine students of SIIB participated at the event ICE AGE which was organized by IMT Nagpur, with 2 teams for the operations game called "Bootstrap", and another 2 teams for an HR event called "Renaissance."

Out of them, the team from SCM which comprised of Nitin Gupta, Abhisake Sharma and Nimit Anand won the 1st prize in "Bootstrap" while Amit Verma from HR won 2nd prize in the HR conclave.

Bootstrap's 1st round was a White Paper submission, on the basis of which they called back 12 teams for the final round. The other 11 teams that participated were from XLRI Jamshedpur , NIRMA,, IIM Kozhikode, SIIB Pune, IMT Nagpur(2), IMT Ghaziabad(2) , NITIE Mumbai, FMS Delhi and SIMS, Pune.

For "Renaissance" the 1st round was a case study, on the basis of which they shortlisted 13 teams. Apart from the 2 teams of SIIB, other participants included IIM(K), XLRI, IMT Ghaziabad, Nirma, NMIMS , NL Dalmiya, and IMT Nagpur.
